



UNIFORM

POLICY

St Luke's community believes that the correct wearing of uniform instills in students a sense of belonging and pride. The expectation is that all families will adhere to this policy.

AIMS:

- To have all students dressed comfortably and appropriately for all seasons and occasions.
- To ensure that students are safely attired for Physical Education, Sport and other times of play.
- To ensure that St Luke's students represent the school with pride by wearing the correct uniform.

Sport	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- St Luke's navy sports shorts, skirt and/or tracksuit pants- St Luke's royal blue and yellow sports top- St Luke's navy & gold tracksuit jacket- White sport socks with St Luke's logo (optional)- Sports runners

Additional Requirements:

- Long hair is to be tied back. Only gold, navy blue or white ribbons, scrunchies, headbands or bows are to be worn.
- St Luke's school broad-brimmed hats are to be worn from the beginning of mid-August until the 1st of May, in line with our SunSmart Policy.
- All items must be purchased through our Supplier Surrey Clothing at www.surreyclothing.com.au as they are our "One-Stop School Uniform Supplier." Surrey

Clothing also has a retail outlet at 424 Station St Box Hill where the uniform can be purchased or via a "Pop Up Shop" to the school twice a term.

- Students are permitted to wear either shorts or long trousers all year round according to their requirements.
- Students are permitted to wear short or long sleeve St Luke's logo white shirt all year round according to their requirements.
- Students are permitted to wear sports shorts/skorts or sports tracksuit pants all year round according to their requirements on designated sports days.
- During extremely cold weather, students will be required to wear a St Luke's windcheater, zip up top, or jacket outside at playtimes.
- Black school shoes need to be worn on all days, except at a teacher's request for 'special events or occasions', PE lesson days and Inter-School Sports days.
- Socks must not have large sporting logos.
- Watches, fitness trackers, studs or sleepers are the only jewellery to be worn.
- All classrooms will display a St Luke's uniform banner to ensure full compliance and understanding of school uniform requirements.
- All articles of clothing must be labelled with an appropriate name.
- During colder months students can wear a St Luke's beanie, scarf and or rain jacket before and after school and at lunch and play times - not during class times.
- If a child is not wearing the correct uniform a note needs to be supplied to the school by the parent/guardian with the reason why.
- If a child is out of uniform and does not have a note from a parent/guardian, then an infringement notice will be sent home. This needs to be signed by a parent/guardian and returned to school.
- 3 infringement notes relating to the same issue, will result in a direct phone call home to the parent/guardian to discuss the matter further.
